1. Welcome & apologies Attending (PN)

 - 2. Introduction of council members (PN)
 Welcome and introduction for in person attendance from MA, MB, SM
- MA first year aerospace student at the University of Adelaide
- MB is a long time associate of AIAA, working for DST for over 20+ years, background rocketry and hypersonics.
- SM works at Myriota as product assistant and studying at Flinders University, studying international relations and political science.
 - 3. Acceptance of minutes from last meeting and action summary (PN)
- SM did minutes for last meeting, due to MA being an apology for an Engineer's Australia event.

ACTION 6.1 (PN) OPEN— Contact the South Australian Science Teachers Association to publicise free educator associate and high school AIAA memberships.

- PN been doing that at every conceivable opportunity to various different teacher groups.
- PN has been hammering free memberships, done a couple of education outreach and been using those contacts to publicise for the upcoming panel before the forum.

ACTION 6.2 (RC) OPEN – Follow up on possible AIAA table at Science Week and Science Alive events.

- RN said science Alive will be happening in November (confirmed). Trying to get as much support, such as AYAA and university.
- AG said she will bring the inflatable space shuttle.
- PN will try to display something from Neumann Space.

ACTION 6.2.1 (MW) OPEN - Check with clubs/ societies at Flinders to see if any could contribute to science alive.

MW said space club is keen and awaiting further detail. Queued up a few interested students and left it as they
moved science alive mid exams, may have difficulty retaining those volunteers. Thus, will come back to it during
mid semester break.

ACTION 6.2.4 (MA) OPEN – Speak with Adelaide Rocketry Division (ARD) and Adelaide Rover team (ART) to see if they would be interested in doing something for science alive.

MA said ARD won't be having a launch anymore due to launch site being interstate and currently in lockdown.

 ACTION 6.2.4.1 (MA) - Follow up with Henry to see if they would be interested in doing something

• RC has booked Flentje theatre in Bar Smith South, lecture theatre has capacity of 305 and currently we are at three quarter capacity. Capped tickets at 200. Event at 5:40pm on the 14th of September, though organised event to kick off at 6:30pm to give speakers enough time to get in and setup. Members will need masks. Covid marshal training and will need badge.

ACTION 9.6.2 (PN) – To organise QR codes for Covid check-in. A few people to get there covid training done (link to be sent), badges for Covid marshals and hand sanitiser to be bought.

- MW said she has posted the event on her linkedin.
- PN said if people want to spam their friends and family, especially if happen to know any teachers that might be interested.

 Melissa at Flinders.

- 4. Correspondence (incoming from AIAA and external) (PN)
 - a) Section awards

- Placed in all six regular awards categories, two of those, first place for young professionals and section student branch, all the others we came in third. Which counts into section annual report.
- MB said as plan for these events frame these as what it will be equal to so that the Adelaide section could be more recognised.
 - b) Space forum (PN)
- We have a booth, put PN & MA as the two people for the complimentary tickets and NH as student ticket. Space forum ticket is still open.
 - b) Sarah Baker careers bay (PN mentioned)
- Sarah is running a careers bay for a couple of days at lot fourteen on the 16th & 17th September. Her advanced science technology group are running a table, they got AYAA involved and wondering if we are able to provide people for the booth, though PN said unsure if we got the time/ people power bandwidth to be involved. PN said will bring this to the students to see if they got a free hour or two to wonder over.

ACTION 4.1 (PN) - Introduce Sarah Baker to MA via email to see if this is something that the student group could support.

- 5. Treasurer report (RC)
- Nothing much this month, except the budget audit which was completed and sent to PN.
- Current balance is \$3000+
 - a) Student Project proposals (RC)
- RC said AIAA sponsors three student projects. Thus, have to give students a heads up for presentation for AIAA grant so they can prepare. At least 2 weeks in advance.
- RC said they will be presenting to AIAA members.
- PN said we will either try to fit it in Region 7 student paper competition, or have them either have them use us as for faculty day presentation. As AIAA has Jason Held's presentation we can have student present a week either side. Depending how exam breaks go, mid-October or end of October should be ok. PN said if we could do it in SWOTVAC they will have some time to breath. If willing to take an evening for presentations.
- PN suggested if there is two weeks break and first week back, they are presenting to faculty we can have it second week of break.
- RC looking at either 6th or 7th of October for presentations.
 - **ACTION 5.1 (RC)** Speak with student project teams and speak about a date for presentation.
- MW said they won't need their whole project team only one from each group is required.
- PN looking to make the presentation hybrid available, looking to wrap up presentations in slightly under an hour and kick-off 6:30pm'ish and get done 7:45pm'ish.
 - **ACTION 5.2 (RC)** to book lecture theatre for presentations.
- MW would like to send specific invites to local businesses in CBD saying "hey we got a few students who finished their grant projects, if you have the opportunity to come in, they would appreciate your time etc" like Stone & Chalk. Additionally, membership list and getting them more engaged.
- MW asked RC if he could send specific email contact list of student project emails so that day before could send them link for zoom.
 - ACTION 5.3 (RC) Send MW student email list for projects.
- PN said might be worth dropping a line to Cass funding for Space forum & science alive.
 - ACTION 5.4 (PN) Speak to Cass funding for Space forum & science alive
- PN said AVALON has been unfortunately cancelled in Melbourne. The plan was to have this year student paper
 conference with Australian international aerospace conference as happening same time as AVALON, so that
 AIAA members could get in for free into the airshow.

- PN had a meeting with Cass & Simon was, members of the executive team in Adelaide to put it out that people
 who would like to volunteer their time for student paper conference (at the time of this meeting there are 9
 completed submissions and 20 uncompleted).
- PN thinks anyone in professional branch could become a judge, though someone else might disagree. RC said in
 the past anyone who is an academic could not be a judge, have to be a member but not an academic.
 ACTION 5.6 (PN) to double check and forward on student conference paper judging (rulings)

6. Membership report (PN)

- PN says we got more highschool members on the section engage page.
- MB says for decades it was hovering over at 30-35 members, PN says we probably have 35-40 non-uni student members and non highschool student members, 12-15 senior members. Anything between 1-3 associate fellows and 5 educator associates.
- MW said expect this will go up in science alive.
- RC asked when do we move from very small section to small section, PN said he thinks 100 members.
- *Discussion on why numbers aren't going up faster*: MW said a lot of students don't actually know what a club is, AG said every single member at Inovor & Myriota should be a member of AIAA. PD said he has had discussions for corporate membership at Neumann space as Australian Space Agency has a corporate membership.
- MW suggested a recruitment lunch for marketing and CEO's
- MB asked what's price and the value composition in getting a corporate membership. PN said \$500 USD a year
 and corporate subscriptions to journals, discounts to courses that count for professional development
 (certification purposes) and webinars.
- MW said once leaving Uni, people want to have access to some sort of professional resource. MB said if ever
 going to publish an aerospace paper, you had to go to an AIAA conference, and attendance in conference would
 qualify you for membership. Though encouraging corporate membership is an interesting way to go about it. AG
 suggested we could do both if companies aren't willing to get a corporate membership, then encouraging
 members to take individual memberships.
- MB suggested lifetime membership which is equivalent to 10 years of membership.

ACTION 6.1 (AG, SM & PN) - Have lunch with Alex Grant to discuss membership opportunity.

ACTION 6.2 (AG & MW) - Investigate a membership recruitment event for SA businesses-targeted at CEO's to take up corporate membership (Hitlist of companies)

- 7. Adelaide Uni Student Branch update (NH)
- MA said the student branch recently had the industry night with Frazer Nash consultancy, DEWC Systems and Smartsat CRC which went well. PN adding that there was about 30 attendees.
- MA said the next thing coming up is the BBQ which will be after mid break (first week).
- MW suggested MA to make list of all the engineering professors and have that as a standard email list, one of the tasks in the student committee could be to just make sure that the professor is still there (every term).
- MA said not a significant increase in membership, and thinks it's because it's a marketing thing, where AIAA only
 seems to be aerospace orientated and since not a significant number of students study it, other engineering
 students think it's just an aerospace club. PN suggested hammering away all the other fields that go into space
 and are informed by space, example software, telecommunications, agriculture, geoscience. Thus to market as
 space is for everyone.
- MA said student branch have two new general committee members
 ACTION 7.1 (MA) Ask if date of student branch for AGM has been set

- 8. Website / Marketing (MW)
- MW said our mail list, mailchip was bouncing as don't have mailing certificate to say we are a gmail address.
- MW was wondering if Adelaide section could have a chat with Lindsay or Lucy to have an actual email address
 certificate, thus more people will receive email. MW said we have 500+ members signed up though 1% opening
 email. Suggesting a .org address to connect that with mailchimp.
- PN clarified by saying we currently we have a mail chimp mailing list, and the login is the AIAA email address.
 With that same email address accounts with Eventbrite to tie it altogether. And the AIAA headquarters have 6 zoom accounts, each could hold 500 people.

ACTION 8.1 (MW) - Speak to Lindsay or Lucy for a section or corporate .org email for two emails, a professional and student branch email address.

- MW said it was a good first show. It became more engaging when it came to the Q&A. MW suggested space education.
- MW said the attendance peaked at 30.
- Dr Rowena Christiansen (one of the speakers) became an AIAA member.

- MW said the space juggling gave a more laid-back perspective on the art side of aerospace. Audience responded well, good engagement in chat, Adam was a seasoned speaker which made it helpful.
- MW said attendance peaked at 19.
- AG suggested we should invite him back down the line.
 - c. Space Forum Panel 14th Sep (PN)
- Covered previously. Refer to correspondence.
- MW said there will be two volunteers from Flinders University space club.

- MW suggested when having chat with Lloyd, if Southern launch would be comfortable having someone from indigenous background be nominated as a spokesperson.

- AG said AIAA have bought a subscription for engineering, technology, history wiki, they are keen for AIAA members to write entries on this wiki, to justify subscription. AG has sent this to mods.
- AG said Julia Mitchell has a display at the SA museum.
- MA mentioned DBF project and how we could look into rebooting the project for student sections. PN said have a look into it and would be happy to support it. RC said he might be able to get the university support.
