### Chair - Opening/Welcome/Section Chair Remarks - Alexandra Dukes

Alex called meeting to order at 6:06pm

Discussed End of Year Section report for Nationals. The report will be moving to web form but not yet released. Still due to be submitted by the Chair at the end of the Section year – 5/31/2023. We will fill out the copy of the spreadsheet from last year with each of the area leads starting now (Link/info in Secretary Section). Alex asked the council to make this a priority.

Discuss National's decision to not provide additional funding to Sections next year (23-24). At the AIAA National dinner last week, Dan indicated this situation was not expected to beforever. Taylor operating with \$ in account before spending. This will change how/when sponsorship and any fund raising is to occur before events. Will pass this change on to next council leadership.

#### Vice Chair Reports - Marshall Lee

Marshall shared summary of the DE&I (Diversity council) meeting held just prior to council meeting (4/26) led by Paul. The event was a cross organization meeting discussing ambassadors/cross org collaboration between teams (AIAA RMS, CSBR, SASE).

Marshall provided a short outbrief on dinner after the Space Symposium w/ AIAA National. Good attendance from RMS section.

Overview of ATS planning status. Making good progress. Discussed possibility of a student/sponsor meet up before the sponsor dinner (slight recruiting/networking). Marshall provided overview of subcommittee activities. Chris, Marshall and Duncan discussed increase in attendance price – still felt reasonable relative to other similar events. Then discussed sponsorship levels noting significant increase of levels over last year with lowest at \$1k. Had a number of \$500 sponsors last year. Suggested pursing an additional \$500 level (maybe 4<sup>th</sup> level). Chris and Marshall took action to meet up on sponsorship.
