- STEM & DEI (Osa)
 - Empower Yourself Summer STEM & Aviation Program (Hiro)
 - Cedric Turner and EY students visited Test Devices in Hudson.
 - Learned about spin testing and jet engines. Hands-on experience in operating small gas turbines and a spin testing machine.
 - Total of 51 participants: Cedric and his students (25 middle & high school students), 8
 engineers, Charlie, and a guest engineer from Rolls-Royce from Test Devices attended the
 event. Cedric said he brought 19 students, so total is 30
 - Cedric and some of his students asked if the WPI team could come to Brockton High again and give a presentation on the Rocket work – Peter Dentch (WPI) took action to make an inquiry to the team.
 - It was a very hot humid day, but everyone appeared to enjoy the visit.



• \$250 STEM & DEI Grants

- Invitation to apply for the grant was posted on the STEM K12 site, and emails were sent out to the New England community in July.
- Christian North requested a STEM grant to build an aerodynamic demonstrator (Kestrel 3500) for various classes he teaches across different projects.





- Aero-Robotics Competition (Allison)- Will restart. AIAA NE has been supporting that historically.
- MIT-LL Beaver Works Summer Institute (Bob, John & Hiro)- 46 applied and 22 selected. 11 teams
 went to the final presentation. Proposal is to shift to weekly lectures. Biggest challenge is the R-Pi kit
 shortage, back order is until July 2023!
