

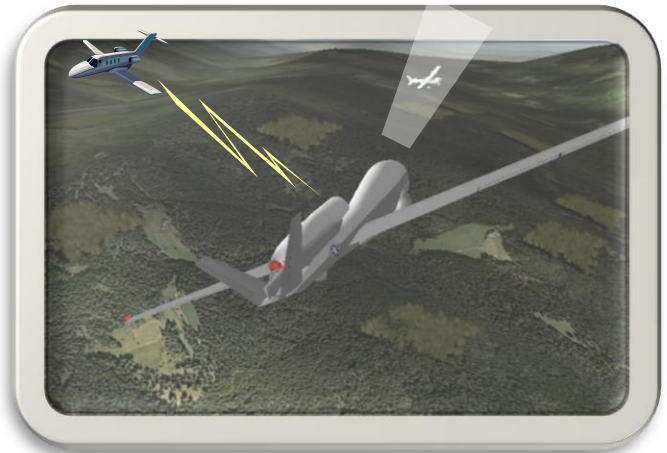

“UAS in the NAS”

***Guest Speaker:
Mr. Robert Smith, AFRL***



Integration of UAS (Unmanned Air Systems) into the National Airspace System (NAS) is rapidly becoming the “hot-button” issue for UAS. DoD wants access to the NAS to fulfill its UAS training requirements. The Department of Homeland Security wants access for border protection missions. Civil authorities want access for security and emergency management and commercial applications for UAS are waiting in the wings. The FAA however, is concerned for the safety and efficiency of the NAS, while AOPA and ALPA would probably prefer for UAS to simply disappear.

Mr. Smith will present an overview of ongoing AFRL technology development efforts and will discuss some of the requirements, policy and acquisition activities throughout the rest of the airspace integration community. This technology is transitioning to operational UAS soon! Are we prepared to accept it?
