- No Styrofoam, bubble-wrap, or fiberglass insulation.
- No balloon designs.
- Weight penalty (5 grams/inch) assessed for center of containers landing outside the 1-foot diameter target area.
- Registration begins 30 minutes before the drop times for the respective age categories.
- Entries will drop from the side of the USS Monitor Replica

- On-site registration begins at 12:30pm for the first Age Group. (optional pre-registration available)
- We recommend devices be built in advance but <u>eggs supplied at the event must be used</u>
