## **U.S. Space Policy & Advanced Performance Rocket Engines**



### **Abstract**

It was premature of the previous administration to mandate the N.A.S.A. to return to the Moon & venture to Mars. It was premature because we do not have advanced performance rocket engines necessary to accomplish these missions. The presentation explains why this is so, and what should be done about it.
