Grimes Field and B-17 Tour Saturday, Oct 15, 2016


The Champaign Aviation Museum is located at the Grimes Field, Urbana, OH Municipal Airport. Since 2005, the museum has been restoring a B-17 World War II bomber. Our local Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA Section will be touring the restoration project. Because Urbana is the seat of Champaign County, the B-17 has been named "Champaign Lady".

In addition to the B-17, the museum also has B-25 and B-26 light bombers, a C-47, a C-45, a Stinson 10A and a Fairchild F-24. Also attached are some maps indicating the location of Urbana (north of Springfield) and Grimes Field, about a 45 minute drive from Dayton. There is also a very nice café at the Airport.


