

# **Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA Artwork Contest Rules**

## **Contest Rules**

- Students enrolled in grades K-12 in a public, private, or home school are eligible to enter.
- Entries must be flat with no pieces attached or hanging off the edges.
- Completed entry form must be glued or taped to the back of the artwork.
- Hand-drawn entries must be submitted on 8.5" x 11" or 9" x 12" paper.
- Digital art must not exceed 10 MB and must be submitted in jpg, gif, tiff, or bmp format
- Any borrowed images within digital entries must be legally acquired and properly cited on the accompanying entry form
- All entries become the property of the Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA and will not be returned.
- Entries must be received by March 26, 2010.

## **Contest Themes**

- K-4- How Flight Has Changed our Lives
- 5-8- The History of Flight
- 9-12- Principles of Flight

## **Judging**

- A sub-committee of the Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA Section Council will judge contest submissions.
- Three winners will be selected from each grade band (K-4, 5-8, 9-12). Winners will receive a certificate of achievement and a \$50 gift card.
- Judging will be completed in May 2010 and winner announced thereafter.
- Winners will be invited to the Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA Annual Banquet and the winning entries may be posted on the Dayton-Cincinnati Website.
