## AIAA Call for Young Professional Award Nominations

- 1. The Young Professional Awards Committee of the St. Louis Section needs your help in identifying YOUNG PROFESSIONAL AWARD candidates. This award recognizes outstanding technical accomplishments of young engineers and scientists in the aerospace field.
- 2. The award is to recognize meritorious technical contributions to the employer's products or goals. The contribution shall have been made during the three years preceding the award. The candidate shall be no older than 35 at the time of the award (37 with at least two years of military service).
- 3. The nomination form is provided on the next page, answers may be filled out on separate pages and attached. Please send completed forms by e-mail to the undersigned committee members (data below), along with any additional information you wish to present. The committee makes its selection based solely on information you provide, so please be complete. The evaluation committee will consist of at least four technical professionals, with complementary areas of expertise.
- 4. Nominations received by April 15, 2023 will be considered for presentation at the AIAA STL Section Awards Banquet in May. Nominations not initially selected, or received after the deadline, will be held for later consideration.
- 5. The Young Professional Award is an excellent way to recognize the outstanding technical performance of young engineers and scientists. Often, this is the first professional recognition that a young engineer or scientist receives from someone other than their employer. Your participation in this nomination process can result in significant encouragement to our younger members.
- 6. If you feel that you may be deserving of this award/recognition, or know of a peer who might be deserving, make sure that the person who is to be nominated fills out the award nomination and presents it to the next level of supervision. If your supervision concurs that this accomplishment is worthy of consideration, they should sign the form as nominator.
