Review/Acceptance of last month's minutes

Reports:

• Treasurer Report (Garrick)

- Wing of Flight Event
 - o Total out cost for the event was \$1,546
 - o Total in from the event \$280
- Current bank account: \$15,579

• Council Election

- Election is closed; Slate is elected.
- 8 responses via the Google Form (1 response via e-mail to Rick stating they saw the ballot, but were not going to vote); unanimous for all positions (except for 1 write-in vote)

- Scott recommends that each of us try to recruit at least 1 more person.

• March 16th Event Recap (Aiden)

- Fantastic event
- Excellent presentation by Kelly about the history of Falcon Field and the RAF pilots who trained there
- Excellent food option (but it was way too much ... had leftovers)
- Seemed that everyone enjoyed the event
- Mingling after the speaker to view the airplanes in the hangar
- About 20 people attended
- Good venue for a social function, but it was 'acceptable' for having the food (sitting on a couch)

• April 9th - Taking Flight 2022 - Paul Kaup's event Recap (Mike)

- AIAA Phoenix had a table where we had information about AIAA and our table top demos (bottle rocket and gravity jugs)
- Vertical Flight Society was next to us (doing similar to us ... sharing about their organization)
 - o Learned by overhearing that they provide scholarships to local students each year
 - o Have 1 or 2 fundraisers to raise money for the scholarship
- Event itself had many other demonstrations and organizations (ERAU, ASU, EAA, hobby shops, etc.)
- Only Mike and Rick supported the event. Scott recommends that we put out a call for volunteers earlier in advance of the next year event.
- Did not have many people stop by. Those who did stop by were interested, but there did not seem to be a lot of general public.
- Possibly something that AIAA can help with the next year event, we could leverage contacting our EA's to get word out about the event to their parents/students.

Could we provide fliers to the teachers so they could just advertise the event. It's a STEM
event ... just so they know about it. If the parents want to attend, they could attend. Not
like a school trip.

• April 15 - ERAU Tour Upcoming Event (Aiden)

• Going to start at 11am. ERAU is going to give us a tour around the various areas of the campus.

May Event

- Scott has reached out to Werner Dahm but have not heard back yet. Will give him another week, if no response then will contact Allison.
- Another potential idea would be a topic about the JWST -- Allison North (?) ... primary engineer for NearCam (sub-contracted out Lockheed)

• Aiden has a new manager who has been interested in Aiden's involvement with AIAA

- Even attended the Falcon Field event
- Suggested that he would be a sponsor for a tour of Boeing Mesa
- Could be a close out event in June

• Scott suggests that we have a closeout BBQ for the Council leadership

- To start the new season and bring the new council members together
- Target for late August

Mike has materials at his house he would like to hand off to someone else on the council

- There is a file on the Google Drive that lists the assets that we have
- 2 pop-up banners; materials from various events; paper handouts which are good for at events

• Potential Idea for Future -- Scholarships
