The proud history of this Cincinnati landmark will be reviewed by Charlie Pyles of Cincinnati Heritage Society and Pattison Lunken will be on hand to represent her family's involvement with the field since its inception through today. Members of the Dayton-Cincinnati AIAA section will present the plaque to Fred Anderton, the current Airport Manager. Come join us on this historic day.
