

Dr. Joseph C. Slater is the Chair of the Department of Mechanical and Materials Engineering at Wright State University. In this presentation he will present an overview of the wide breadth of activities in education and research in the department along with department performance trends and successes and ongoing and planned initiatives in research and education.

Dr. Slater formed the Aerospace Systems Engineering Masters program at WSU in 2012 to address the educational needs pertinent to growing UAV activities at AFRL and local industry. Has served in numerous administrative role including Associate Dean for Industrial and Government Relations, director of the Aerospace Professional Development Center, Interim Associate VP for Career and Workforce Development, and became chair of the Department of Mechanical and Materials Engineering in July 2016. Joseph Slater received his BS ASE ('89), MS ASE ('91), and PhD ME ('93) from the State University of New York at Buffalo and has been faculty at Wright State University since 1993. He is an Associate Fellow of American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, a Fellow of ASME, and an active member of the AIAA Structural Dynamics Technical Committee having recently served as the chair of the 2016 Dynamics Specialists Conference as well as serving on the DCASS organizing committee from 2008-2010.
