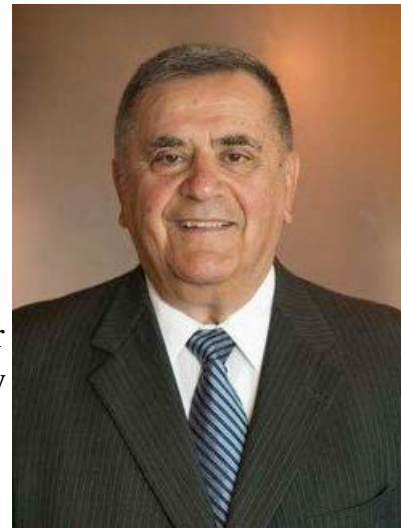

Dr. Russo was the Executive Director, Aeronautical Systems Center, Air Force Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, responsible for an annual budget of \$18 billion and a work force of 12,000 people. He is now the Executive Advisor to the President of the University of Dayton, a board member or advisor for several commercial and not-for-profit organizations, and the Chairman of the Board of Aerospace Technologies Associates, LLC. He earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Rochester, master's degree from the Air Force Institute of Technology and PhD from the Ohio State University.



Air Camp is a week-long summer camp adventure in aviation and aeronautics for middle school students, which takes place at the birthplace of flight – Dayton, Ohio. At Air Camp, students experience the rich and exciting aviation and educational resources in the Dayton region, from the place where the Wright Brothers invented flight to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. Home base for the week is Wright State University. The purpose of Air Camp is to inspire students to new heights of scholarship, leadership and citizenship, as they experience the wonders of flight and study the science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) of aviation and aeronautics. It's a week packed with fun, adventure, learning, and challenge. At Air Camp, students work together and solo to: Take flight training and fly as a copilot, Learn about the science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) that propel aviation, Explore the National Museum of the United States Air Force, Discover the mechanics and operations of commercial aviation, See behind the scenes at the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Meet the scientists at the Air Force Research Laboratory, and more!
