Dr. Emily Fehrman Cory is a General Engineer in the AFRL Small Business Directorate, Air Force Research Laboratory, Air Force Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. Dr. Emily Fehrman Cory is the director of the AFRL Maker Hub, the innovation makerspace for WPAFB. Emily was formerly the Deputy Program Manager of America Makes, the National Additive Manufacturing Innovation Institute. She has also managed programs in carbon nanotube wiring technologies and electronics reliability. Her prior areas of research include nanofabrication techniques for optical devices, including thin film deposition and characterization, photolithography, nanoimprint lithography and inkjet printing. She is also a founding member of Make It Dayton, a grassroots group of Makers supporting and growing the Maker Community in Dayton.
