Vendors, suppliers, small businesses, entrepreneurs, and local academia will be invited to attend.

## **Value Proposition for Prime Contractors**

Primes will have the ability to find potential subcontractors, vendors, collaborators, innovative technology, and/or acquisitions among the attendees. By providing a "one-stop-shop" for these companies, we save them time and money since they do not have to research and visit each one of these organizations.

### **Value Proposition for Small Business/Entrepreneurs**

This event provides an opportunity for small businesses to meet with prime contractor and government agency representatives in one day. It will also provide educational workshops and business planning sessions.
